Sapporo: A city with night views that represent Japan Spectacular views beyond your imagination

Along with Kobe and Nagasaki, Sapporo is one of the Japan's new top 3 cities for night views. You will be fascinated by the beautiful night views visible from the summits, towers, and a observation deck at high-rise building and also various night views such as the White Illumination,

What are the New Three **Major Night Views of Japan?**

The night view of Sapporo was chosen as one of the Japan's new top 3 cities for night views along with Nagasaki and Kobe in a questionnaire survey "your choice best night view," which the Night View Tourism Convention Bureau conducted to 4,500 "Night View Certifiers" around Japan in order to introduce them as a new Japanese brand to Japanese and overseas tourists and to revitalize night view tourism.

(In the questionnaire, one chose 5 night view spots.)



Appreciate the "layers of light," visible from different heights.

Not many know that Sapporo White Illumination was the forerunner for various illumination events held across Japan.

It is said that illumination displays began in 1900 (Meiji 33) in Japan, when the battleships flashed their lights across the sea in Kobe during a fleet review at night. However, today's large-scaled illumination events to attract tourists actually originated in Sapporo White Illumination, which was first held in 1981(Showa 56). You could say that in Japan, Sapporo was the origin of "festival of lights" to combine the city with lights.



1st Sapporo White Illumination

Sapporo is surrounded by mountains and you can enjoy spectacular panoramic views from the mountains, parks on the hills, the TV tower, Ferris Wheel, and observation decks at buildings in the city. Another interesting fact is that you can enjoy the night view of Sapporo from various locations at different altitudes, such as Mt. Moiwa Summit Observation Deck (531m), Horomi Pass Lookout Parking Lot (320m), Okurayama Viewing Point (307m), JR TOWER Observatory T38 (160m), Asahiyama Memorial Park (137.5m), Sapporo TV Tower Observatory Deck (90m), NORIA







(Ferris Wheel) (78m), and even from low-rise hotels. Indeed, there are "layers of light" that sparkle and glitter in the night sky of Sapporo, which are like stratums of history. It is unique, and unlike any other city in Japan.

These "layers of light" provide us with a night view that resembles countless stars glittering in the universe, as well as night views that allow us to feel the glamourous breath of a metropolis. One can be both swept away into a fantastic dreamland, or gain a sense of elation from the bright neon signs of the city.

There is such a variety of view points in

Sapporo, which is why the night view was chosen as one of the Japan's new top 3 cities for night views and has been attracting interest as a night view that represents Japan lately.

Sapporo; the city where illumination festival began, and where "layers of light" provide various night views. It is difficult to know and visit all of these viewpoints in just a day or two. However, we hope you will utilize this guide book as an introduction to the profound "Sapporo night view"



1 Mt. Moiwa Summit Observation Deck

A Carpet of Light that Spreads Across the Ishikari Plain

The observatory on the top of Mt. Moiwa is located at an elevation of 531 meters. Take the ropeway and Morris car (mini cable car) to the summit, and you will be rewarded with a spectacular night view, which is like a carpet of jewels scattered across the Ishikari Plain. Awesome!

02 Sapporo Clock Tower

Beautifully Illuminated Pure White Symbol of the Northland, Sapporo

Built in 1878 according to the design set forth by Professor Clark, the building was intended to be used for a training center for the Sapporo Agricultural University (the former school before it became Hokkaido University). The symbol of Sapporo tells time to the citizens with hourly bells. After sunset, the building is lit up, adding a dab of pure white color to the grey business district.


Urban Meets Nature; Symbolic Night View of Odori Park
