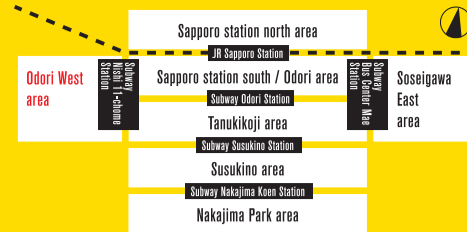

Inspiration comes from forgetting everyday life

Old maps show that the Odori West area was the "edge" of Sapporo's development and the boundary between villages. A little further west is Maruyama, and a little further north is an area called Soen, but these areas "do not yet" have a name.

The retro streetscape with streetcars and the nostalgic multi-tenant buildings are impressive. In the rooms of these buildings, there are general stores and cafes with unique retro atmospheres where you can experience the craftsmanship and artwork of artists and literary works. Museums and lawns surrounded by nature are also attractive places to take a breather, forget about everyday life, and be inspired, whether it is on a sunny, rainy, or snowy day. It is notable as an "old" yet "new" area of Sapporo.

From the outside, it looks like just an apartment. But actually ... This mysterious building, with its unique stores in every room, is like Kowloon Castle. Once you unlock the art lock by pressing the chime of the store you are interested in, you will find a variety of stores of all genres: for living, making things, relaxing, eating, fashion, handicrafts, and for learning, etc. The concierge's top pick is Takechasu Records, a record shop open only on weekends. "Records" are experiencing a resurgence in popularity around the world, especially among young people, as the widespread use of smartphones has brought back the lo-fi style of music appreciation. Why don't you come and find your favorite record?



Hokkaido Governor's Official Residence

The Western-style building seen through the trees in the lush garden was built by Mitsui Zaibatsu in 1936 and is marked on old maps as the "Mitsui Club." In 1953, it became the "Hokkaido Governor's Residence," and its spacious grounds also house the "Hokkaido Migishi Kotaro Museum of Art. It is also used for filming movies and TV dramas, and if you are lucky, you may see Ezo-risu, Hokkaido squirrels and wild birds. The area is also popular as an Instagram-worthy spot. The babbling brook and sunlight filtering through the trees are also pleasant, and the area is a popular resting place for citizens who enjoy forest bathing and reading books on



● Sweets

This area is a must for sweets lovers. The nostalgic pudding a la mode at "6 Kissa Tsubara Tsubara," the morning-only fruit sandwiches at "9 ATELIER Morihiko," and the parfait filled with coffee jelly at "8 Bandou Coffee" are must-try items. In addition, there are many famous French pastry stores such as "Patisserie ASAKA," "Patisserie SHIYA," and "Bon Vivant." It is a wide area, but you won't feel guilty if you combine your visit to sweets with a stroll around the area.



● Lunch

This area, where the office district, educational district, and residential area come together, is characterized by many attractive lunch restaurants. I recommend "10 Hotel", where zangi and mabo-men are popular, and "4 gravity", where you can compare nihachi and juwari soba noodles. Yes, it is also a fierce curry battle zone such as "2 THE END CAFE." It's hard to decide what to eat!

Take a rest in the quiet greenery amidst the hustle and bustle

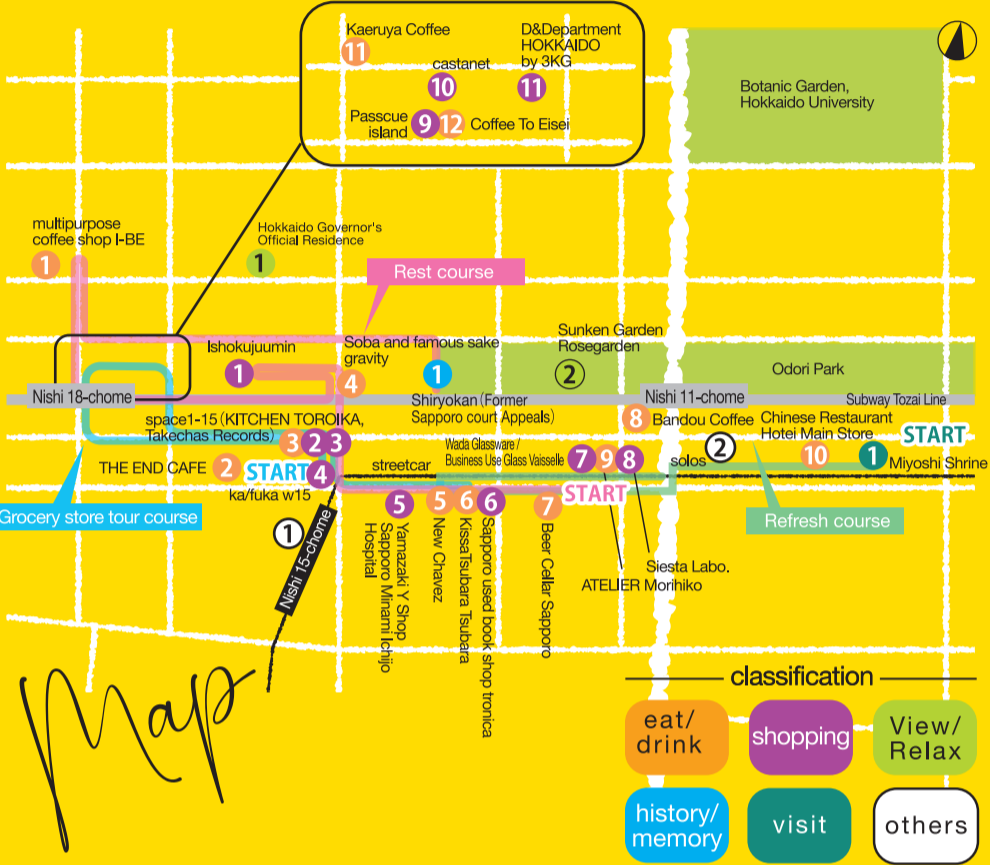
